Introduction

Every two years Sachi Foundation offers financial support for individuals or community groups that are able to work together to foster a culture of learning to create something unique in order to spread happiness or to increase capacity for the sustainable effort well beyond the period of our support. Examples include Community-based gardening, Tuition programs, School repair projects, Mobile school funding, Happiness research works, Festival and cultural events, empowering projects, Research Programs, etc.

A typical successful application usually has coherent planning stages supported with regular participatory reflection meetings and response-receptive processes. Getting such a community-based project off the ground will take a lot of effort on behalf of all the members. So It is important to determine your team dedication for your project success and continuation.

The Application Form

You recently contacted our Grant information assessment team. Please help us to decide your eligibility by completing this application. The central focus of your application must be spread of happiness and culture of learning.

After you return your form through email, our assessment team go through your application details and if needed may request further information. After that, we will submit your application to the board for their decision. Please note, we have a limited budget and not necessary all the successful application will receive their requested funding for the period under consideration.

If an application is not approved as a two-year sustaining grant, the board may still consider the application for single year or half-year support. In the case of unsatisfactory evaluations, Sachi Foundation retains the right to stop funding at any point. Sachi Foundation also does not guarantee funding after the grant period is completed, although after consultation with the assessment team, applicants may reapply.
